Better identifying and supporting Young Carers faced with the serious illness of a parent: Study of Parent's Experience of Help from their Children



Many children and adolescents who are faced with a parent with a serious illness as cancer can also provide regular and significant support at home. They are called Young Carers (YCs). This situation provokes many consequences for young people, who often need professional help. However, despite all these impacts on their lives, Young Carers still remain hidden from the social and health system, as well as from their own families in some situations. Indeed, some results suggest that ill parents are not fully aware of the role and consequences of such situation on their child(ren).

The aim of this study is therefore to explore the views and experiences of parents with a serious illness on the support provided by their child(ren), their own quality of life and that of their child(ren).

Pauline Justin has participated in this project during her PhD and still working on it. The aim of this presentation is to present the preliminary results of this research and to open a discussion on the difficulty of conducting such a study.
